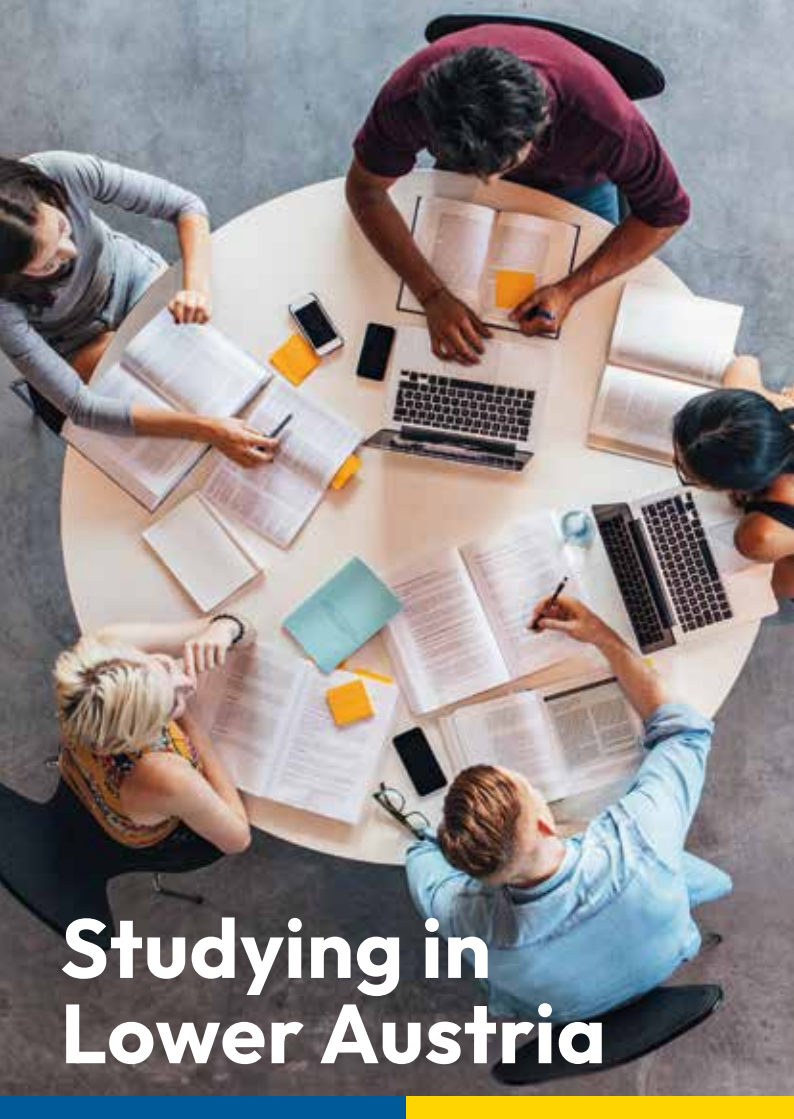

Bertha von Suttner Private University St. Pölten (BSU)

The Bertha von Suttner Private University St. Pölten considers itself to be a future-oriented development space for society and science. With a focus on psychotherapy, social work, inclusion, and psychology, it upholds the central values – humanism and peace – of its namesake.



Danube Private University (DPU)

DPU offers degree programs and continuing education courses in the fields of dentistry and human medicine. It is characterized by innovation, a team of renowned scientists who serve as partners to students in teaching and research, as well as the international diversity of its student body.



University of Applied Sciences Wiener Neustadt (FH Wr. Neustadt)

Founded in 1994, FH Wr. Neustadt offers a broad range of continuing education and study courses at its locations in Wr. Neustadt, Tulln, Wieselburg, Francisco Josephinum Wieselburg, and Rudolfinerhaus Vienna. These programs cover the fields of economics, technology, health, sports, and security. The university stands for practical training, international networking, and innovative research work.



Ferdinand Porsche FERNFH

The Ferdinand Porsche FernFH combines competencies from business administration, computer science, psychology, health sciences, and social sciences, conducting socially relevant, application-oriented research. Its study model is designed as a distance learning program that combines digital teaching with targeted on-site phases.



IMC Krems – University of Applied Sciences

IMC Krems is a university of applied sciences offering practical degree programs in the fields of economics, health, natural sciences, and technology at its three locations: Krems, Mistelbach, and Horn. Courses taught in English, international guest lecturers, and students from over 70 nations highlight the international orientation of IMC Krems.



Institute of Science and Technology Austria (ISTA)

ISTA conducts basic research in natural sciences, mathematics, and computer science. The institute's graduate school offers students with a bachelor's or master's degree fully funded PhD positions. A rotation in the first year of the PhD encourages the interdisciplinary approach of the top research center.



Karl Landsteiner University for Health Sciences (KL)

KL is an internationally recognized educational and research institution at Campus Krems. The university offers modern, needs-oriented education and training, as well as scientific research in the key fields of health sciences, medicine, and psychology – for the benefit of the general public.



Catholic University ITI

The Catholic University ITI is a university under papal law. It offers a state-recognized full-time degree program in Catholic theology as well as other degree programs. The international campus is a place of exchange between different cultures and a living embodiment of the universal church.



KPH Vienna/Lower Austria, Campus St. Pölten

The KPH Vienna/Lower Austria is Austria's largest private pedagogical university with locations in Vienna and Lower Austria. Its range of courses include teacher training programs for primary and secondary general education, a Bachelor's program in elementary education, and cooperations in the field of religious pedagogy.



New Design University (NDU)

The NDU is a private university offering degree programs and university courses in the fields of business administration (BWL), event management, interior design, graphic design, and design & crafts. The university is distinguished by a high level of personal support and the integration of theory with practical application.



University College of Teacher Education Lower Austria (PH NÖ)

The courses on offer at the University College of Teacher Education Lower Austria include programs for primary education and elementary pedagogy, as well as vocational pedagogy. Furthermore, a wide selection of continuing education programs and university courses is offered. The University College of Teacher Education Lower Austria offers programs at three locations: Baden, Melk, and Hollabrunn.



Philosophical-Theological University Benedict XVI Heiligenkreuz

Founded in 1802 as a monastic institute, elevated to a university in 1976, and since 2007 a university under papal law, the University Heiligenkreuz is the largest training institution for priesthood candidates and members of religious orders in the German-speaking world. It offers studies in Catholic specialized theology.



Theresian Military Academy (TherMilAk)

Founded in 1751, the Theresian Military Academy is the world's oldest active military academy dedicated exclusively to officer training. The University of Applied Sciences for Military Leadership now offers basic officer training as well as continuing education for the Austrian Armed Forces.



University for Continuing Education Krems

The University for Continuing Education Krems offers a broad range of part-time study programs including Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD degrees, as well as short programs. As a leading public university for continuing education, it specializes in the advanced qualification for working professionals. In research, it combines basic research and application to help address current and future societal challenges.



University of Applied Sciences St. Pölten (USTP)

USTP stands for innovative teaching, applied research, and – as the lead university of the European University Alliance E³UDRES² – for a lived European openness. Students benefit from personal support, state-of-the-art infrastructure, and future-orientated study programs in nine thematic areas. The university is located in St. Pölten and in Mauer.

The range of courses and study programs in Lower Austria has increased significantly in recent decades. New locations have established themselves as innovative research institutions. The network of universities and educational institutions will continue to grow in the future.

Europacampus Hainburg

The Europacampus Hainburg is being established as a future project for education, research, and innovation. The goal is to create an equally international and interdisciplinary educational and research site focused on future themes such as Green & Human-Centered Technologies, sustainable innovations and applied science.
